On behalf of all of the board and staff at Burbank Housing we want to thank you for the outpouring of compassion. The number of people who have reached out to offer their support has been a source of comfort and inspiration for all of us during this difficult time.

While conditions on the ground continue to evolve, I am happy to report that as of today none of the Burbank properties in Sonoma or Napa County have been damaged by the wildfires. A number of our communities in Santa Rosa are within the fire zone and are under voluntary or mandatory evacuation. In addition power and gas have been shut off to a number of our other nearby properties.

The Burbank family itself has been directly impacted. Three of our employees and a board member have confirmed the loss of their homes due to fires. Many others have homes still in danger or close friends and family members who have lost their homes.

We will continue to monitor the situation on the ground and update you as more information comes in.

In the meantime, some of you have asked how you can support our community. We know that the residents of our community will need support as they are able to return to their homes.
